



Handy Harry has mixed up all his beanbags! Can you help him sort them out again? Without leaving your hoop, can you throw the beanbags back into the matching coloured buckets?

RESOURCES

A mix of coloured bean bags

Buckets to match the coloured bean bags

Hoops for the players to stand in

TEACHING POINTS:

Encourage the children to look and aim before they throw the beanbag

MAKING IT HARDER:

- Make it a race- can they get all their beanbags sorted as someone counts down from 20?
- Extend the distance the beanbags are thrown over.

MAKING IT EASIER:

Move one colour bucket to each child at a time, enabling them to adjust their aim as they throw all of that colour beanbags in one after another

LINKS TO THE EARLY LEARNING GOALS:
