



Look at the words on the fence.

Choose one person to be Handy

Harry - they will shout out one of the words. Can you splat the word with a beanbag before Harry counts to 5?

RESOURCES

Sounds or words the group can decode attached to a wall or fence

TEACHING POINTS:

Children need to turn their bodies towards to target and swing their arm back to ensure the momentum is built before releasing the beanbag. Encourage an underarm throw.

MAKING IT HARDER:

- Encourage children to step forward on the throwing side to give the throw more force
- Try using a small ball instead of a beanbag

MAKING IT EASIER:

 Move the children closer to the targets and encourage them to step across to be directly in front of where they are throwing
