



Handy Harry is so careful when he's throwing that he follows instructions carefully.

Your friend will ask you to throw beanbags onto, under, over, in front of, to the side of and behind the chair – let's see if you are as careful as Harry!

TEACHING POINTS:

Encourage the children to look carefully as they swing back and release the bean bag. They will need to moderate the power of their throw so a few practice games may help!

MAKING IT HARDER:

- Write down a simple order of positions for the caller to follow, and give an identical one to another pair. Which couple can listen carefully and finish first?

MAKING IT EASIER:

- Follow the example of a friend, stating where they have thrown their beanbag. For example, the adult throws onto the seat of the chair, the child says 'it is on the chair' and then throws their own on also.
