Dance scarves

TEACHING POINTS:

Remind children to look at the scarf as it floats down but also to take care as they move around the space not to bump into anyone else! This challenge might by tricky on a breezy day outdoors!

MAKING IT HARDER:

- Can the children throw and catch in pairs with 2 scarves which must pass each time?
- Challenge the children to see who can throw the highest and still catch the scarf

MAKING IT EASIER:

 Encourage the children to just throw the scarf up a short distance.

LINKS TO THE EARLY LEARNING GOALS:

PD, M&H - Children show good control and coordination in large and small movements. They move confidently in a range of ways, safely negotiating space. They handle equipment effectively.

PSE, MR - Children play co-operatively, taking turns with others.
